### NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

### JUNE 30, 2016

### PURPOSE OF THE ORGANIZATION

The Royal Canadian Air Force Association Trust (the "Trust") is affiliated with the Royal Canadian Air Force Association of Canada/Association de l'Aviation royale canadienne, created in accordance with the Trust Agreement, and is responsible for raising and distributing funds at the national level for the Association's charitable programs. The Trust is a registered charitable organization.

### 1. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations. The Trust's significant accounting policies are as follows:

### (a) Revenue Recognition

The Trust follows the deferral method of accounting for contributions. Restricted contributions are recognized as revenue in the year in which related restrictions are met. Unrestricted contributions are recognized as revenue when received or receivable, if the amount can be reasonably estimated and collection is reasonably assured.

### (b) Volunteer Services

The Trust receives the services of volunteers, the cost of which cannot be reasonably estimated. Therefore, no representation of this expense has been included in these financial statements.

### (c) Financial Instruments

The Trust's financial instruments consist of cash, investments due from the Royal Canadian Air Force Association of Canada/Association de l'Aviation royale canadienne and accounts payable and accrued liabilities.

It is management's opinion that the Trust is not exposed to significant interest rate, currency, liquidity or credit risks arising from these financial instruments.

### 1. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (Cont'd)

### (d) Use of estimates

The preparation of financial statements in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, revenue and expenses and the disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities. Actual results could differ from management's best estimates as additional information become available in the future.

### (e) Investments

Investments consist of a mutual fund recorded at fair market value.

### 2. CASH RESTRICTED

During the year the Trust acted as administrator for the projects of the Typhoon Memorial Maintenance Fund, Bomber Command Memorial, RAF Leeming Service, Bomber Command Memorial Book, Battle of Britain Fund, 408 Squadron Association, Air Cadet Medals, Air Cadet League of Canada and the Snowbirds 40th Anniversary. Funds held in the Trust bank account relating to these projects which have not yet been disbursed are recorded in deferred revenue (note 5). The amounts will be recognized as revenue and expenses when the funds are disbursed.

### 3. RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The Royal Canadian Air Force Association Trust is affiliated with the Royal Canadian Air Force Association of Canada/Association de l'Aviation royale canadienne. The entities share office space and administrative services.

### 4. ACCOUNTS PAYABLE AND ACCRUED LIABILITIES

The Trust had no liability for either sales taxes or payroll and withholding taxes on its balance sheet.
